11	<b>Award 1 mark</b> for both lines drawn correctly to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Summers are getting wetter.</li> <li>● Winters are getting less cold.</li> </ul>	1
12	<b>Award 1 mark</b> for: The Earth freezes.	1
13	<b>Award 1 mark</b> for any answer that gives a reason for future climate change, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● It will continue to get warmer and wetter because that seems to be the way it is going.</li> <li>● It will get colder because we have not had an ice age for a long time.</li> <li>● Do not accept any answer that describes future climate change without giving a reason.</li> </ul>	1
14	<b>Award 1 mark</b> for any answer that explains why the title is suitable, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● It tells you what the text is all about.</li> <li>● It is a summary of the text.</li> </ul>	1
15	<b>Award 1 mark</b> for icy or chilly	1
16	<b>Award 1 mark</b> for a clap of thunder	1
17	<b>Award 1 mark</b> for: Splattering	1
